Known for producing wines under the Cru Bourgeois classification, Château de Malleret combines tradition with modern winemaking techniques to enhance the elegance and complexity of its wines.</p>				
Vineyard	<p>The vineyards of Château de Malleret lie in the heart of Haut-Médoc, covering around 54 hectares with gravelly soils ideal for Bordeaux varietals. Primarily planted with Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon, along with smaller plots of Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc, the vineyard benefits from meticulous care to ensure the highest quality fruit.</p>

Vinification	<p>At Château de Malleret, grapes are gently filled by gravity and vinified plot by plot to preserve their unique characteristics. Fermentation occurs at controlled temperatures of 27-28°C in a combination of concrete and wood tanks, with regular punching down to enhance extraction and color. Maturing for 12 months in the barrel.</p> <p>Cabernet Sauvignon 52%, Merlot: 46%, Petit Verdot: 2%</p> <p>ABV: 13.5%</p>
